Dr Bettina E. Schmidt, University of Wales Trinity St David, director of the Alister Hardy Religious Experience Research Centre in Lampeter, Vice-President of TRS UK and Honorary Secretary of the British Association for Study of Religion. She has published extensively on Caribbean and Latin American religions, identity, cultural theories and migration. Her academic interests include the anthropology of religion, diaspora identity, religious experience, urban studies, medical anthropology and gender issues. Her main fieldworks were conducted in Mexico, Puerto Rico, Ecuador, New York City, and, more recently, in São Paulo, Brazil, about spirit possession and trance. She is the author of *Caribbean Diaspora in the USA: Diversity of Caribbean Religions in New York City* (2008, Ashgate), *Einführung in die Religionsethnologie* (2008, Reimer Verlag Berlin), and co-editor of *Spirit Possession and Trance: New Interdisciplinary Perspectives* (2010, Continuum).
