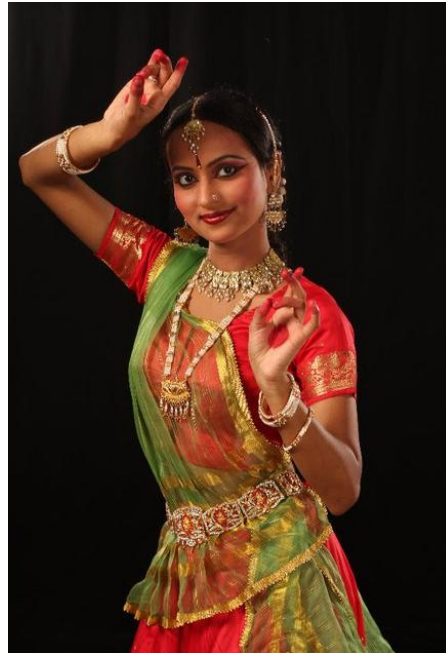


Kathak



ICC Kathak teacher, Dr. Anjana Jha, is from Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh, India. She is an exponent of the 'Jaipur Gharana' style of Kathak.

Dr. Anjana started learning Kathak from the age of eight from Gurus Sukhdev Singh Khushwa. She later underwent training under Kathak maestro guru "**Pt. Shri Rajendra Gangani**" of the Jaipur Gharana. She took admission into the prestigious institute of Kathak dance- Kathak Kendra where she was a teacher before joining in the same capacity at ICC, Bangkok.

She completed her diploma and post graduate diploma from the Kathak Kendra, New Delhi and her PhD from "Indra Kala Sangeet Vishwavidyalaya, Khairagarh University Chatisgarh."

An empanelled artist of the ICCR, Anjana Jha is an 'A' grade artist of Delhi Doordarshan. She has performed extensively in India and abroad. She has performed at the Konark Mahotsav, Delhi and Jaipur Kathak Mahotsav and has performed at festivals in Iceland, Singapore, Switzerland, Malaysia, Bahrain, Oman, Qatar, Kuwait, U.A.E. to name a few.
